Description: In this course we will study trigonometry. This subject, in addition to M1050, are meant to prepare you for calculus. The **prerequisite** material for this course is found in M1010. The material for both M1060 (this course) and M1050 can be found in the course book. We will cover Chapters 4, 5, 6, and 10.7-10.9

Exams: There will be weekly quizzes (lasting 20 minutes each) that will account for 40 percent of your grade. There will be a final worth 30 percent. The problems will be similar to what you will encounter on the homeworks. Books/notes are NOT allowed during the exams or quizzes. Only scientific calculators (no graphing) are allowed during the quizzes (NO calculator is allowed on the final).
